



# Angus Buddy Entitlement Schemes



The Angus Buddy Entitlement Schemes aim is to support and promote healthy living and physical activity with service users who cannot access the wide range of leisure and sports activities, provided through leisure facilities, on their own.

The Angus Buddy Entitlement Schemes will allow the service user that requires support/help to attend and take part in physical activity sessions.

The following terms and conditions apply. A signed application form is your formal acceptance of these terms and conditions.

**Terms and Conditions for the Angus Buddy Entitlement Card**

- 1. All applicants must have a current Routes to Leisure card.
- 2. Cards must be presented by the service users to allow the helper access to the named activity.
- 3. Card may be used to book facilities up to 7 days in advance.
- 4. The cardholder must comply with the management rules of the council's leisure services.
- 5. Cards may be used at all Angus Council indoor leisure facilities (including Town Halls Activities run by Leisure Services).
- 6. Cards remain the property of Angus Council.
- 7. Angus Council reserves the right to refuse or suspend the use of any cards.
- 8. Lost cards should be reported as soon as possible to the LMIS Administration team based at The Yard, Queenswell Road, Forfar. An administration fee will be charged for the replacement card.
- 9. Periodic reviews of the card entitlement will be carried out in case of any change in circumstances.
